

Prizes

A shield will be presented to the tournament champion, to hold until the anniversary of the event. The winner will receive £50 and there will be second and third prizes of £35 and £25 respectively. There will also be grading restricted prizes of £16 each and a junior prize.

We will seek to resolve all ties, firstly by the sum of progressive scores and then by the sum of opponents' scores. Should this fail to resolve the tie, the prize will be shared equally.

Quickplay Rules

Each player must make all of his moves within the thirty minutes on his clock. Detailed rules will be available at the venue. In any dispute the controller's decision is final.

Entry fees

For entries postmarked on or before the 30th May 2009, the entry fee will be £7.00. For juniors (under the age of

sixteen on the day of the tournament) the fee will be £3.50.

Late entries will be subject to a surcharge of £2.00. No entries will be accepted on the day of the tournament, and the organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry.

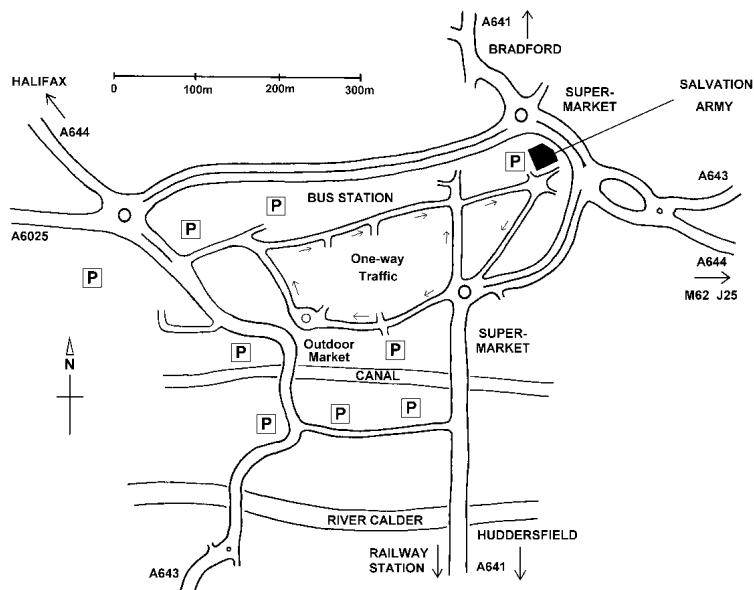

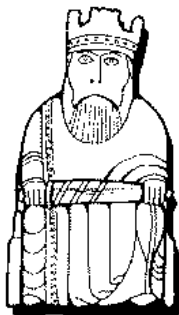


Venue
